Because of all of these unanswered questions staff have also tabled the City Council hearing on the alternatives that was supposed to happen on April 6th.

Now that we are on a roll we need to keep that ball rolling! We need to **keep sending in comments** and **attend every meeting** where we can continue to support smart growth, and save our farmland from clustered housing.

So mark your calendars for the following key dates- and keep emailing and attending all that you can. We need to keep building momentum so get three other people to join you and ask them to each get three more.
